Read This Before You Order!

All films listed in Blackhawk's Bargain Bulletin are good used normal image 16mm. sound prints unless otherwise indicated. Cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel; other one reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel.

Blackhawk can continually offer you these exceptional buys only by eliminating all possibility of credit losses, and by operating our organization at the utmost efficiency. Therefore, irrespective of your credit rating, our terms are **CASH WITH ORDER**, or **10% DEPOSIT WITH ORDER**, **BALANCE C. O. D.** You have nothing to lose — our guarantee protects you.

This guarantee provides that if for any reason you do not wish to retain any films or merchandise you order from Blackhawk, you may ship them back to us, transportation paid, within five days after you receive them, together with a copy of your invoice, and we'll give you full credit. Of course, returned merchandise must be in substantially the same condition when returned as when you received it.

Blackhawk prices do not include postage except in a few instances where films are shown as "postpaid" at the prices listed. On C. O. D. shipments, postage will be collected along with the cost of the films. However, if you wish to remit in full with your order, you may include the following amounts to cover packing, postage and insurance, irrespective of your location in the United States:

Three 100' prints count as one 400' reel in figuring postage and insurance. Each feature picture counts as eight 400' reels in figuring postage and insurance. For empty reels, cans, cases, etc., allow 20% of purchase price for postage and insurance.

On many classes of films listed here, additional savings can be made by ordering six, twelve or more prints at a time. These discounts, however, apply only to quantities purchased within that class, and not to assortments of several classes of films. Discounts do not apply to any new or used films unless specifically offered in the listing.

Feature Pictures

This listing of good used feature pictures is, to the best of our knowledge, the biggest and most varied list of such titles ever offered in 16mm. sound. Many of these titles have previously been available on lease only and, under special license, are available on a purchase basis only from Blackhawk. Even a few features in full color are included in the list.

All of these features are complete and in good condition. Naturally, some prints have seen more use than others. However, all have been hand inspected, have good sprocket holes, and are free from an excessive number of splices. They are assembled on 1600' capacity reels and have adequate lengths of leaders and trailers.

On many titles we have but a single print remaining on hand — on others we have as many as six or eight prints in stock. In making a selection, we urge you to give second and third choices wherever possible. We'll send them only when your first choices have already been sold.

You can save money by ordering features in quantity. On an order for six or more feature prints, you may take a discount of 5% from our already low prices — on twelve or more prints, 10%.

Many moderate size film libraries across the country depend on Blackhawk for certain of their feature requirements. Blackhawk,

you know, takes in good used 16mm. sound features and short subjects at substantial allowances. Generally, the allowance on features is about two-thirds of our anticipated re-sale price. Thus, on a feature which we would expect to sell at \$39.95, your allowance would be in the neighborhood of \$25.00. Any good 16mm. sound features — whether obtained from us or not — will be accepted in exchange for other material on such a basis. Thus, it is a simple and inexpensive matter to keep libraries supplied with a change of titles as frequently as rental requirements necessitate. You can have the use of a feature picture for a matter of months at what amounts to an exchange fee of \$15.00 or \$20.00 — and we guarantee satisfaction.

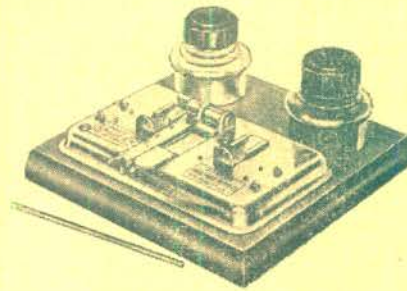

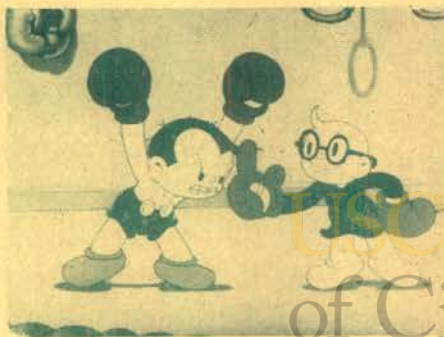

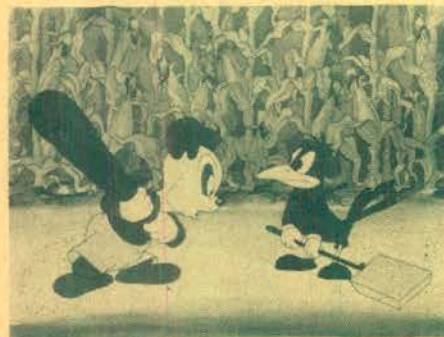
