All films listed in Blackhawk's Bargain Bulletin are good used normal image 16mm. sound prints unless otherwise indicated. Cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel; other one reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel.

The 100' 16mm. musical films identified as "R-I" are used prints of productions made originally for projection in Panoram coin-operated machines by such companies as R. C. M. (Roosevelt, Coslow, Mills); Globe; Cameo; Minoco; Filmcraft and Phono-view. The pictorial image is reversed on the screen when compared to normal 16mm. prints. However, with most of these subjects the only point where this is noticeable is in the main title which, when projected as a normal 16mm. print, appears reversed on the screen.

Blackhawk can continually offer you these exceptional buys only by eliminating all possibility of credit losses, and by operating our organization at the utmost efficiency. Therefore, irrespective of your credit rating, our terms are **CASH WITH ORDER**, or **10% DEPOSIT WITH ORDER**, **BALANCE C. O. D.** You have nothing to lose — our guarantee protects you.

This guarantee provides that if for any reason you do not wish to retain any films or merchandise you order from Blackhawk, you may ship them back to us, transportation paid, within five days after you receive them, together with a copy of your invoice, and we'll give you full credit. Of course, returned merchandise must be in substantially the same condition when returned as when you received it.

Blackhawk prices do not include postage except in a few instances where films are shown as "postpaid" at the prices listed. On C. O. D. shipments, postage will be collected along with the cost of the films. However, if you wish to remit in full with your order, you may include the following amounts to cover packing, postage and insurance, irrespective of your location in the United States:



Three 100' prints count as one 400' reel in figuring postage and insurance. Each feature picture counts as eight 400' reels in figuring postage and insurance. For empty reels, cans, cases, etc., allow 20% of purchase price for postage and insurance.

On many classes of films listed here, additional savings can be made by ordering six, twelve or more prints at a time. These discounts, however, apply only to quantities purchased within that class, and not to assortments of several classes of films. Discounts do not apply to any new or used films unless specifically offered in the listing.

However, in most of these subjects the only point where this is noticeable is in the main title which, when projected as a normal 16mm. print, appears reversed on the screen. For many uses, the titles may be removed.

Blackhawk, by offering related types of films in these "DeLuxe Packages" of three, six, twelve or thirteen units saves on sorting and handling by assembling dozens of packages at a time. This saving is passed along to you for, when any of these units are sold singly, they are usually priced at \$1.98 or \$2.49 each.

There may be, without notice, temporary substitutions of one or more titles in any package because of momentary unavailability of

sufficient prints of some of the regularly assigned subjects. However, we assure you that any such substitutions will be of greater value to those replaced. And, any such substitutions will be of similar type.

In these DeLuxe Packages of R-I* Sound Musical Films, we will permit replacement of not more than two units, with other units of our selection, in a package of twelve or thirteen units (or one unit in a package of three or six units) at an additional charge of \$1.00 for each replaced unit. Thus, in a \$13.95 package of twelve units incorporating two replacements will cost you \$15.95. A \$9.95 package of six units incorporating one replacement will cost you \$10.95. 



They are assembled on 1600' capacity reels and have adequate lengths of leaders and trailers.

On many titles we have but a single print remaining on hand — on others we have as many as six or eight prints in stock. In making a selection, we urge you to give second and third choices wherever possible. We'll send them only when your first choices have already been sold.

You can save money by ordering features in quantity. On an order for six or more feature prints, you may take a discount of 5% from our already low prices — on twelve or more prints, 10%.






