We have the biggest stock — the widest selection of titles — consistently the lowest prices — and the flat guarantee that anything purchased from us may be returned for full credit within five days (with a copy of your invoice) if for any reason you do not wish to retain it.

Occasionally we get a letter such as this: "The print of SO-AND-SO which you sent must be the last print you have of that subject for the sound is terrible. Therefore, please refund my money." More often than not it isn't the last print we have, and even if it were it would not be justification for the sound being poor. Sometimes in a case like this, the customer is actually right — the sound is terrible. More frequently, a checking reveals that something must have been out of adjustment with his projector — or the room in which he was showing had an extremely bad acoustical condition. But regardless, he gets his money back.

The point that we want to bring out, however, is that the bulk of the film offerings contained in our listings are used films — but they are used prints of first quality subjects that have been hand inspected by our staff. Everything about them appears to be good. Yet in rare instances something will show up on screening that could not be detected by hand inspection. But, to give you the big bargains we do, we cannot undertake to screen check every used print we sell. Should we do that, the price of films we offer would be increased to the point that they would cease to be the bargains they now are. Therefore, if you ever get a print from us which, upon screening, proves to be unsatisfactory in any way, it isn't because we're trying to pull a fast one — it's because we can't employ a staff of several people to screen prints day and night to weed out the one-in-a-thousand that may turn out to be below par, without increasing the price per print excessively. You do the screening, you make the saving, and if you get a lemon it's the law of averages and not the deliberate intention of Blackhawk. And if you do get a lemon, fire it back to us and we'll make it right.

In an early issue of Blackhawk's Bargain Bulletin we expect to show you some view of our stock rooms and warehouse. You'll see the whole walls and rooms of shelving jammed full of features, one reelers and 100' musicals — and a great fireproof warehouse with thousands of boxes each filled with dozens to hundreds of prints of 16mm. sound films. Our stock now totals over 200,000 prints of features and short subjects. It's Blackhawk's buying power, and ability to put cash on the line, that makes possible the kind of bargains you get here week after week. And remember, you're the judge. Feature Pictures

This listing of good used feature pictures is, to the best of our knowledge, the biggest and most varied list of such titles ever offered in 16mm. sound. Many of these titles have previously been available on lease only and, under special license, are available on a purchase basis only from Blackhawk. Even a few features in full color are included in the list.

All of these features are complete and in good condition. Naturally, some prints have seen more use than others. However, all have been hand inspected, have good sprocket holes, and are free from an excessive number of splices. They are assembled on 1600' capacity reels and have adequate lengths of leaders and trailers.

On many titles we have but a single print remaining on hand — on others we have as many as six or eight prints in stock. In making a selection, we urge you to give second and third choices wherever possible. We'll send them only when your first choices have already been sold.

You can save money by ordering features in quantity. On an order for six or more feature prints, you may take a discount of 5% from our already low prices — on twelve or more prints, 10%.

Many moderate size film libraries across the country depend on Blackhawk for certain of their feature requirements. Blackhawk,

you know, takes in good used 16mm. sound features and short subjects at substantial allowances. Generally, the allowance on feature is about two-thirds of our anticipated re-sale price. Thus, on a feature which we would expect to sell at \$39.95, your allowance would be in the neighborhood of \$25.00. Any good 16mm. sound features — whether obtained from us or not — will be accepted in exchange for other material on such a basis. Thus, it is a simple and inexpensive matter to keep libraries supplied with a change of titles as frequently as rental requirements necessitate. You can have the use of a feature picture for a matter of months at what amounts to an exchange fee of \$15.00 or \$20.00 — and we guarantee satisfaction.

Prices of feature pictures do not include postage. If shipment is to go C. O. D., the cost of postage and insurance can be collected along with the balance due on the film. However, if you wish to save C. O. D. charges by remitting in advance, you may remit the following amounts to cover the cost of postage, insurance and packing, irrespective of your location in the United States:

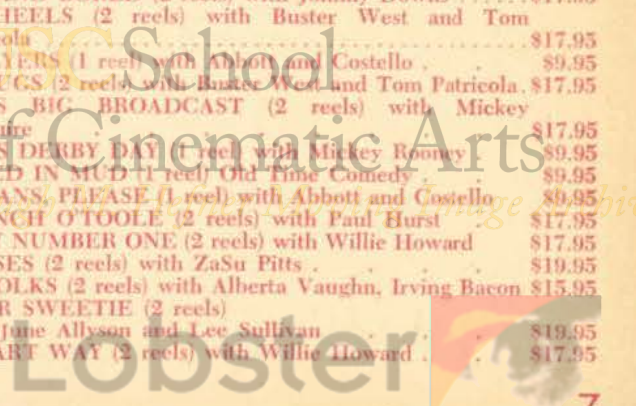

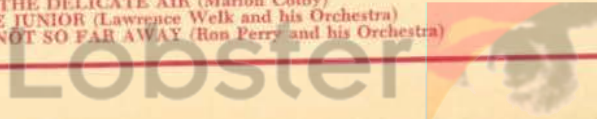
