



All films listed in Blackhawk's Bargain Bulletin are good used normal image 16mm. sound prints unless otherwise indicated. Cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel; other one reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel. All films of one reel length and over are supplied on reels.

The 100' 16mm. musical films identified as "R-I" are used prints of productions made originally for projection in Panoram coin-operated machines by such companies as R. C. M. (Roosevelt, Cosgrove, Mills); Globe; Cameo; Minoco; Filmcraft and Phono-view. The pictorial image is reversed on the screen when compared to normal 16mm. prints. However, with most of these subjects the only point where this is noticeable is the main title which, when projected as a normal 16mm. print, appears reversed on the screen. These 100' 16mm. R-I sound musical films are not supplied on reels, but in individual rolls.

Blackhawk can continually offer you these exceptional buys only by eliminating all possibility of credit losses, and by operating our organization at the utmost efficiency. All foreign orders, including Canada and Mexico, must be for a minimum of \$10.00 and must be paid in U. S. funds.






