"What kind of an outfit are you anyway? Two weeks ago I ordered a print of BLAH-DE-BLAH from your current catalog. You wrote me it was out of stock. Now I get your new catalog and you have it listed."

"I ordered the day I got your new catalog, but the film I wanted was already gone."

"Take me off your list. You couldn't supply the film I ordered."

Boy, do we ever take a beating — sometimes — from some of our otherwise good friends! And, frankly, it's because we still have not been able to get across to you the whole story of Blackhawk's unusual type of operation.

As a matter of fact, it's the kind of service that Blackhawk renders to producers, distributors, libraries and individuals that makes it possible for us to offer the kind of bargains we do — the fact that at Blackhawk, dollar for dollar, you get so much more.

Best, dealing with quantities that are limited, there is absolutely no way we can avoid disappointing some of you some of the time. (And, believe us, we're more disappointed than you are.) We could disappoint fewer of you, or disappoint some of you less often, by raising our prices — then not so many of you would order. Our films then wouldn't be as big bargains as they are now — and you wouldn't be happy! We wouldn't sell as many prints — and we wouldn't be happy!

We could, at the time the catalog is printed, show our stock of prints on hand. But providing this detailed information would slow down the issuance of the catalog. And besides, many subjects on which we had twelve prints at press time might be sold out sooner than some on which we had but one. And, anyway, the quantity we had on hand at the time the catalog was printed still wouldn't be the available quantity at the time you received your copy of the catalog.

We could do any of these things, and more, but nothing we've thought of yet would be a real solution. We have, recently, made a change that we believe will help quite a bit. Where we used to prepare just one catalog a month, and mail the whole issue at one time to everyone on our list, we now have two issues—prepared and mailed about two weeks apart. These two issues are exactly alike except for the center section devoted to listings of used films.

The first issue of the catalog is mailed to half our mailing list. Then, two weeks later, we prepare the second issue—using exactly the same information as in the first edition with this exception: We check all the listings of used prints to eliminate everything sold and add everything we have acquired since the first issue went to press. In this way, when the second half of our customers receive their issue, they have completely up-to-date information on listings, and the group which receives the first issue also has the very latest information available to us at the time we started printing.

You may be interested in just how these catalogs are prepared.

Preparation of each month's Blackhawk catalog begins with the listing of all new and used material added for sale since the previous month's issue. Copy work progresses a day or two before composition begins. A day or two later printing begins. It takes from five days to a week to print and bind, another day or two to mail. This means that from the time preparation of each catalog starts until you actually get your copy may be from 12 to 18 days.

Before each form is run on the press, last minute eliminations are made so that all listings are absolutely correct at the time of printing. But, in spite of all this checking, some of the items will have been sold by the time you get your copy of the catalog.

We are, however, doing our very best to give you outstanding bargains in new and used 16mm. sound and silent, and new 8mm. silent films. We want to bring you the biggest selection of the best films at the lowest prices ever.

## A New Chapter

Now for the new chapter of THE BLACKHAWK STORY. Lately, we have been running into the same problem on projector sales as we have had right along on films — often we get several orders for the same used projector. Of course, it's a matter of "first come, first served," and after the first order has been filled, we just have to disappoint the others who want that same projector. Sometimes, fortunately, we know that we will be getting in several more of that same model projector and can offer to hold one of them for the other people who might be interested—and often this works out very satisfactorily. In fact, our customers have been so pleased with this method of handling their orders, when we would otherwise have had to disappoint them, that we believe we can work out a regular procedure along these lines that will be even better for you.

If you are looking for a good used projector, write and tell us what make and model you want. You can probably tell from the catalog listings of other used projectors about what you can expect to pay for such a model—if you aren't able to determine in that way, ask us what we think you will have to pay; we'll be glad to give you an estimate. Then, we'll hold your request on file for up to three months, and as soon as we get a projector of the kind you want we'll notify you immediately with a full description of it. You can take it or leave it as you wish—you are under no obligation to buy it. You can always order any other projector you see listed in our catalog in the meantime, but having your request in with us means that you will have first call on the particular make and model you are most interested in. No holding charge or obligation.

We think this will be a convenience that many of you will want to take advantage of. Remember, we can deliver our deliveries to your home most of the time, and we'll even deliver your projector to your door to deliver. Always More Movies For Your Money.

# USED 16mm. SOUND FEATURES

All prints listed on pages 12 through 18 are good used 16mm. sound prints except for any group specifically identified as used 16mm. silent subjects.

We usually have only a few used prints of a title - sometimes only one. This means that within two or three weeks after the mailing of this catalog, more and more of these used titles will be sold out. Keep this in mind when you order. Order early, and, in justice to yourself, give us an alternate list of titles. We'll never send an alternate unless your top choices are already out of stock. But remember - we can't sell what we don't have - and the used prints we offer are in great demand.

This section, printed on green paper, was the last part of the catalog to be printed. It was all the press only one or two days before the general mailing of the catalog was made. At the time it went to press, prints of all the subjects listed were in stock ready for shipment. Normally, within two or three weeks after mailing, 50% or more of the titles will have been sold.

As to the length of these films - cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel, other one-reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two-reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel. All films of one reel length and over are supplied on reels.

The pictorial image is reversed on the screen, with sound recorded to normal 16mm. prints. However, with most of these subjects the only point where this is noticeable is in the main title which, when projected as a normal 16mm. print, appears reversed on the screen. These 100" 16mm. R-I Sound Musical Films are not supplied on reels, but in individual rolls.

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
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
