




THE GOLDEN ARROW

THE SUPER CHIEF covers the 3 1/2 hour streamlined journey from Chicago to Los Angeles of the Santa Fe's newly equipped streamliner. It shows the accommodations of the modern sleeping cars, the Pleasure Dome car with its dining room, the dining car proper, the observation. And it shows the scenic Mexico-Arizona country through which the Santa Fe travels. The train is shown in detail, both inside and out, and there are a number of swell shots across Kansas and Colorado.

WESTERN PACIFIC FAST FREIGHT

If you have any idea that a freight train isn't in the running with a streamliner as glamorous as THE SUPER CHIEF — take a look at WESTERN PACIFIC FAST FREIGHT. It's the run of No. 62, The Fruitblock, from Oakland, Calif., to Salt Lake City — all the way behind a 6,000-horsepower Electro-Motive diesel locomotive. Much of the footage was shot in the Feather River Canyon where the W.P. tackles the Sierra Nevada's — and much of the footage shot in the canyon was photographed from a helicopter. Mighty spectacular stuff it is, too.

One extremely interesting sequence shows the working of Centralized Traffic Control, the modern train dispatching system that permits a man at one control panel to direct trains over a 100 to 500-mile length of main line. It shows how the Fruitblock, and the W. P.'s Vista-Dome streamliner, THE CALIFORNIA ZEPHYR meet and pass on the single track main line, and a siding, without either train stopping. It's a whiz of a film.






