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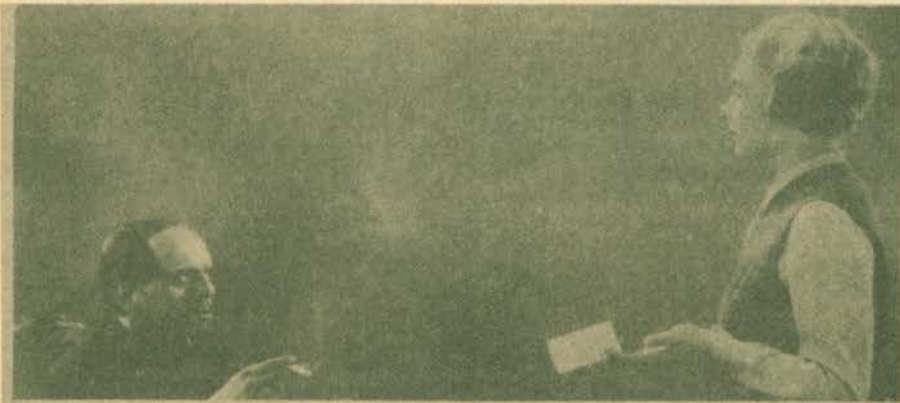

Through a very complicated series of events, which culminates in a train wreck in a tunnel, staged by Haigh in an attempt to kill the agent, and the gassing of his bank, by his own orders, to avoid discovery of his hide-away, he is surrounded at the theatre when performing as a clown and shoots himself on stage as part of the act.

**SPIES** is one of the most famous screen thrillers distinguished by great directorial virtuosity, and made more interesting by the debate among film historians as to whether or not it reflects the mind and social conditions which produced the Third Reich. 89 min. MUS. BW.

## THE GREAT DICTATOR' (1940) CHARLIE CHAPLIN, PAULETTE GODDARD

Chaplin plays a dual role in this, his first dialogue film: the modest, unassuming proprietor of a small barber shop in the Jewish ghetto of Tomania, and that country's maniacal dictator, Adenoid Hynkel. Through a complicated set of circumstances, Hynkel and the barber become mistaken for one another by Hynkel's troops. Forced into an impersonation of Hynkel at a mass rally celebrating Tomania's successful invasion of Austerlich, the barber steps even further out of character and becomes Charles Chaplin. His impassioned speech on the evils of militarism, delivered directly to the audience, created an instant sensation, and Chaplin was asked twice to repeat it on network radio broadcasts. 128 min. BW

"The Eyes Have It" made in 1928 stars Ben Turpin with Georgia O'Dell, Helen Gilmore and Jack Lipson. Ben needs a day away from mother-in-law, but things go badly until he rescues a young lady and she invites him to her apartment. But the hounds are already on his trail — wifey and her mother smell a rat and guess who they catch, up to his neck in a compromising situation?

Overlooked for years by film scholars, Turpin's final comedy series was made for Weiss Brothers-Artclass after he retired from Sennett's employ. No one really knows why one of the leading comics of the era would retire from the best comedy lot in the business and then work for an independent, but Ben is up to farm in this comedy and delivers the laughs fast and furiously.

"The Cannon Ball" made in 1915 stars Chester Conklin. Here it's pandemonium in the Boom Powder factory when explosives expert Chester arrives to inspect operations. His methods are most unusual, but you must admit the wily little cuss knows his powder and his women!

But as sharp as he is, Chester's no match for the dim-witted Keystone Cops once they swing into action in this rousing melee of trick photography and high-flying actors. One of the most popular of the Keystone's made for Mutual, "The Cannon Ball" contains the ingredients that made "The Fun Factory" world famous and should be in every collector's library.
