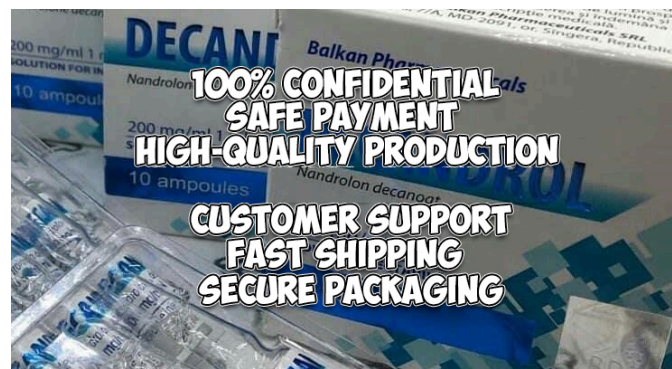

The good news is that you have options! Testosterone Replacement therapy is the process where men with low testosterone are treated with external (exogenous) testosterone to get their levels back into the normal range. The most common forms of TRT administered in the UK are injections, gels and sometimes testosterone pellets. Testosterone Replacement Therapy in the UK is available at CJA Balance as a gel or injection. Testosterone gel: The gel is applied topically to either the arms, shoulders or abdomen for 2 to 5 hours where the testosterone seeps through the skin. You should not touch another person until the gel is fully absorbed as this can be transferred to them. Testosterone is a performance-enhancing drug. It is sometimes used illegally by athletes to get a competitive advantage over their peers. TRT is not allowed in most competitions in the UK or internationally. To get TRT in the UK you

must first obtain a TRT blood test then get approval from a doctor that your testosterone levels are indeed lower than they should be. After this you may be given a range of potential treatment options, one potentially being TRT (testosterone replacement therapy).

TRT in the UK - for women - the bottom line right now It's much easier to obtain a private prescription for personal use and/or order from online pharmacies based abroad that don't require a prescription. Right now, the chances of women getting testosterone therapy through the NHS is basically zero, if you are a woman. The bad news is that most UK Endocrinologists are not up to date with the current state of TD and TRT management. In the UK, the licenced treatment for TD is Testosterone Undeconate (Nebido), this is a long acting ester, traditionally prescribed every 8-14 weeks. The other common option offered is the gel. Generally, the normal total testosterone level in men is above 12 nmol/L, a borderline level is 8-12 nmol/L and a low level is <8 nmol/L. These ranges may vary slightly depending on the laboratory which performs your test.
