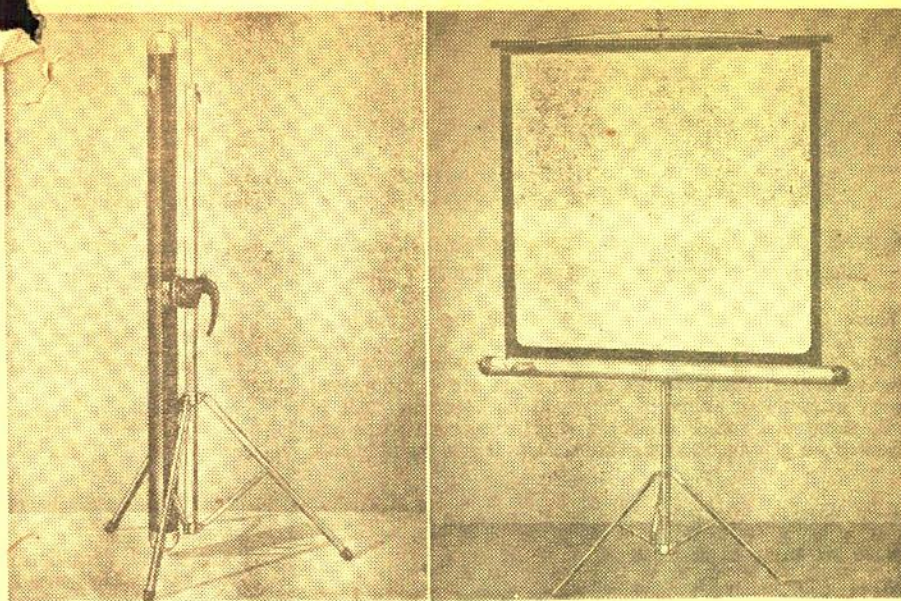

If your requirements are for a projector for day-in and day-out use, a new projector might be a better buy for you. Blackhawk Films does not presently supply new 16mm. sound equipment, but can recommend to you a reputable audio-visual dealer in your own community from whom you can obtain a new unit and in whom you can have confidence. We'll be glad to furnish this information on request.

Blackhawk is the nation's clearing house for top grade used 16mm. sound projectors. We have customers in every state of the nation—in Alaska, Hawaii, the West Indies, South America, Asia and in the Pacific. Some one near you is probably the happy purchaser of one of Blackhawk's used machines.

We don't buy junk, and we don't buy models on which the manufacturer is no longer prepared to supply repair parts. Machines we buy are principally trade-ins from the country's audio-visual dealers, and most of them have been used by schools. We require that units we buy be complete and in operating condition, with good castings and good cases. We then clean them and adjust them in our own department or at a qualified service station operating with us on contract.

You have five days after you receive a projector to determine whether or not it meets your requirements. You may return it within this five day period for exchange or refund if for any reason you do not wish to retain it.

PROJECTORS ARE NOT SHIPPED PREPAID, and for the most part they are not mailable. You pay transportation charges on receipt. Most 2-case projectors weigh, when packed, just under 100 pounds. Most single-case projectors, about 40 pounds. Between Davenport, Iowa, and most Post Offices, the weight limit is 20 pounds, to some others it is 40 pounds. Only to a relatively few destinations may parcel post shipments of up to 70 pounds now be made. This means that projector shipments must go by Railway Express, rail or truck freight. 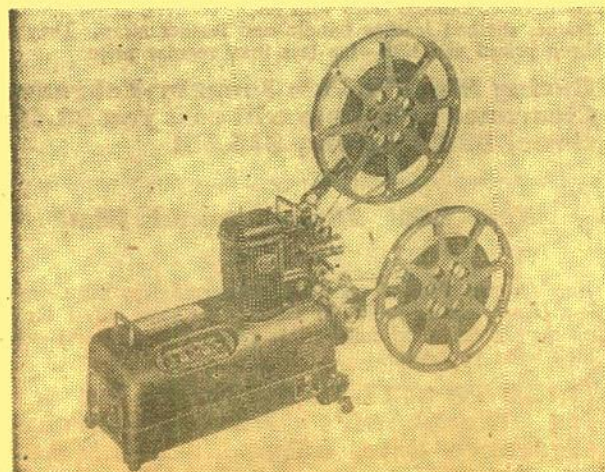

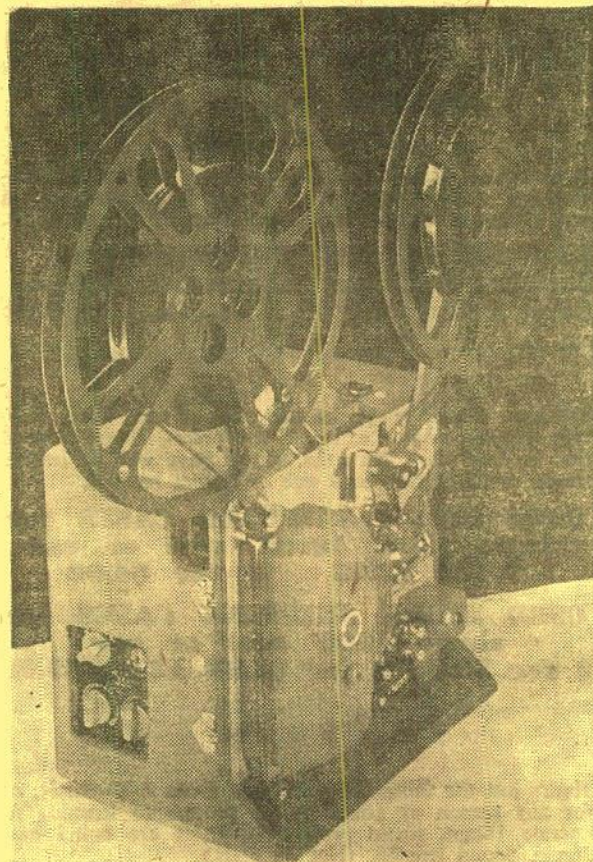

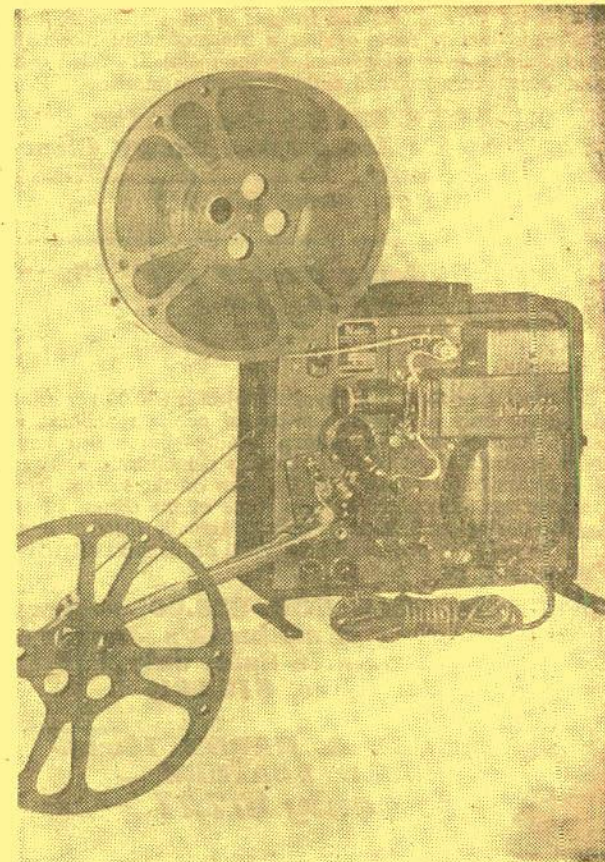

Of course, returned merchandise must be in substantially the same condition when returned as when you received it. If films are returned or sent for trade-in, it will usually be ten days to two weeks before exchange merchandise or refund check will reach you.

Foreign customers should establish confirmed irrevocable letters of credit in favor of Blackhawk Films Inc., Davenport, Iowa, U.S.A., at American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, Illinois, U.S.A., and send such letters through that bank, and, in turn, through First Trust and Savings Bank, Davenport, Iowa, U.S.A., for payment to Blackhawk Films, Inc.

Foreign customers can secure full information as to Blackhawk Film's credit and reliability by having their banking houses check with Dun and Bradstreet in the United States, and with either First Trust and Savings Bank or Davenport Bank and Trust Company here in Davenport, Iowa, U.S.A.

Foreign shipments—excluding Canada and Mexico—must total a minimum of \$10.00. And, all foreign orders, including Canada and Mexico, must be paid in U. S. funds unless arrangements have been made in advance for payments in the currency of the purchaser's native country.

Export shipments, other than those by parcel post or air, should be packed in wooden boxes for shipment by sea. An additional charge of \$6.00, over the cost of merchandise and actual transportation, is made for each such box required and for placing therein waterproof paper.

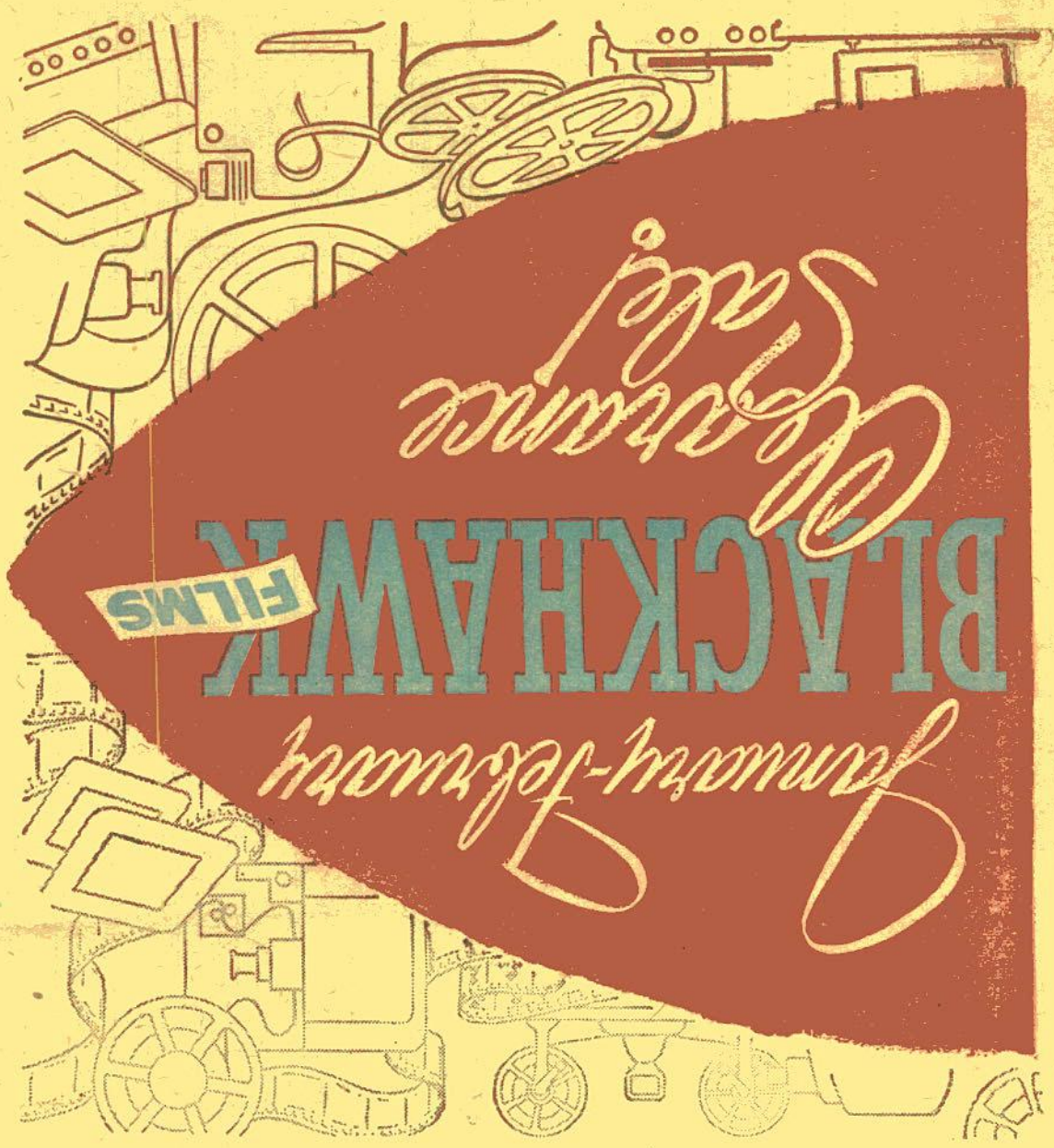
