What should I spray?

Accelerator is a product we love to see in foliar fertilizers for our conventional growers. Accelerator:

- Is a 1-8-5 low-salt-index liquid product
- Contains the most plant-available forms of phosphorus, potassium, and traces (including magnesium)
- Contains nitrogen complexed with carbon for maximum effectiveness

When should I spray?

Some good "windows of opportunity" for foliar application are:

- Corn – V3-V7; right before tassel; at brown silk
- Beans – early growth; right before reproductive stage; early pod fill; late pod fill
- Hay and/or Pasture – early spring greenup; after each cutting of hay; as regrowth appears on pastures
