"Way Out West" (B&W Version)

Laurel and Hardy, Rosina Lawrence, James Finlayson
"Way Out West" is one of the funniest Laurel and Hardy comedies ever made. Unlike many comedy films of the 1930's, "Way Out West" has no romantic subplot, so the film has more time to devote to comedy. The film concerns the efforts of Laurel and Hardy to deliver the deed to a gold mine to a young lady living in a lawless western town. The film's villain, played by James Finlayson, hears about the deed and gets it by sending an imposter to pose for the deed's rightful owner. Laurel and Hardy soon discover that they have been tricked, and spend the rest of the film recovering the deed and delivering it to the proper person. Laurel and Hardy perform very well in their films, and their supporting actors and actresses do also. James Finlayson turns in a particularly funny performance as the film's villain. Rosina Lawrence acts acceptably well as Mary Roberts, the rightful owner of the gold mine.

Owing to the short length (65 minutes) of "Way Out West," a short subject named "Red Noses" and starring Thelma Todd and Zasu Pitts is included on the "Way Out West" videotape. Thelma and Zasu, along with veteran comedy actor Billy Gilbert, act fairly well, but the material they have to work with is weak. "Red Noses" is mildly amusing, but not nearly as funny as "Way Out West."
