All prints listed in this colored section are good used 16mm. sound prints except for one group specifically identified as used 16mm. or 8mm. silent subjects.

We usually have only a few used titles of a title - sometimes only one. This means that within two or three weeks after the mailing of this catalog, more and more of these used titles will be sold out. Keep this in mind when you order. Order early, and, in justice to yourself, give us an alternate list of titles. We'll never send an alternate unless your top choices are already out of stock. But remember - we can't sell what we don't have - and the used prints we offer are in great demand.

This section was the last part of the catalog to be printed. It was all the press only one or two days before the general mailing of the catalog was made. At the time it went to press, prints of all the subjects listed were in stock ready for shipment. Normally, within two or three weeks after mailing, 50% or more of the titles will have been sold.

As to the length of 16mm. films - cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel; other one-reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two-reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel. All films of one reel length and over are supplied on reels. 8mm. films measure just one-half the length of 16mm. subjects.

This guarantee provides for any reason you do not wish to retain any films or merchandise you order from Blackhawk, you may return them back to us, transportation paid, within five days after you receive them, together with a copy of your invoice, and we'll give you full credit. Of course, returned merchandise must be in substantially the same condition when returned as when you received it. If films are returned or sent for trade-in, it will usually be ten days to two weeks before exchange merchandise or refund check will reach you.

Read This Before You Order!

Blackhawk can continually offer you these exceptional buys only by eliminating all possibility of credit losses, and by operating our organization at the utmost efficiency. Therefore, irrespective of your credit rating, our terms are CASH WITH ORDER, or (inside continental United States) C.O.D. However, even inside continental United States, a 10% deposit must accompany all C.O.D. orders of \$50.00 or more. Outside continental United States—and this includes Alaska, Canada, Hawaii, Mexico, Porto Rico and the Panama Canal Zone—we can handle orders only when remittances in full are included. In all cases, we urge you to remit by postal or express money orders, or by bank drafts. Foreign orders must be in U. S. funds. Do not send currency or coins—even by registered mail—for you do so at your own risk.

We have found that we cannot economically handle orders totaling less than \$2.50 (or less than \$10.00 from outside the Continental United States), so henceforth we cannot accept any order that does not total at least these minimums. You will see footnotes reminding you of this throughout the catalog. Just remember, if you live in the United States, your order must be for a minimum of \$2.50. If you live outside the Continental United States, your order must be for a minimum of \$10.00 and must be paid in U. S. funds. (This includes orders from Canada and Mexico.)

Purchasers in Iowa must pay the 2% Iowa State Retail Sales Tax except in the case of retailers who are purchasing materials for resale, in which case this fact must be clearly stated on the order.

Under the new postal regulations, parcels may not exceed 20 lbs. in weight nor 72 inches in girth. This means generally that all moderate to large shipments of films must be shipped to you by Railway Express, and that shipments of projectors, screens (except gas folding cloth screens) and moderate to large quantities of reels and cans must go by express instead of parcel post. Whenever an item has to be shipped by express, we will send it express collect for the transportation, which you will pay on delivery.

However, on small moderate size shipments, which may be sent by parcel post, if you wish to remit in full with your order, you may include the appropriate amount to cover packing, postage and insurance, based on your address, as covered by the following three territorial groupings:
