**WHAT DO THEY MEAN?**

All those numbers above mean something very definite to us. You've undoubtedly noticed that we've started numbering each of the films and items of equipment in our catalog, and asking you to give the number when you order. If you will do that — and give the complete number each time — we'll be sure to supply just what you want.

It has been quite a problem for us to be sure we were shipping just what our customers were ordering as we often have on hand new 16mm, sound, 16mm, silent (both headline and complete), 8mm, complete, and 8mm, headline versions of the same film — and we may even have a used print of that same film, too. If some one simply ordered the film by title, without specifying the version he wanted, we just didn't know what to ship.

Therefore, we've started using the numbers to identify the films. Each number and letter in the code means a lot, so be sure to use them all in your order. For example, 16 SDU 26C11 means a 16mm, sound, used print of a 2-reel color travel subject; 8 SLN 30B9 identifies an 8mm, silent new print of a black and white 1-reel sport

subject. Thus, the first group of numbers tells whether the film is 16mm. or 8mm. The group of three letters tells whether it is sound (SD) or silent (SL), and whether new (N) or used (U). The final group, composed of both letters and numbers, identifies the film as to type (whether a cartoon, sport, feature, musical, etc.) and length (1-reel, 2-reel, etc.); whether black and white or color; and the last numbers are only for identification within the office.

So you can be sure both the number and title when you order will give you exactly what you want, and as soon as you reach us and be sure we're doing what you want us to do means no delays, and better and quicker service for you.

Our numbering system means, too, that YOU can identify at a glance just what kind of film each title is. There's no question as to whether a certain film is 8mm. or 16mm., sound or silent, or used, if you'll let the numbers work for you in giving information.

This section was the last part of the catalog to be printed. It was off the press only one or two days before the general mailing of the catalog was made. At the time it went to press, prints of all the subjects listed were in stock ready for shipment. Normally, within two or three weeks after mailing, 50% or more of the titles will have been sold.

As to the length of 16mm. films - cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel; other one-reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two-reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 300 feet to a reel. All films of one reel length and over are supplied on reels.
