USED 16mm. SOUND PRINTS

IMPORTANT! Read This Before Ordering.

We usually have only a few used prints of a title - sometimes only one - and the means that within two or three weeks after the mailing of this catalog, more and more of these used titles will be sold out. Keep this in mind when you order. Order early, and, in justice to yourself, give us an alternate list of titles. We'll never send an alternate unless your top choice is already sold out of stock. But remember - we can't sell what we don't have - and the used prints we offer are in great demand.

This section was the last part of the catalog to be printed. It was all the stock only one or two days before the general mailing of the catalog was made. At the time it went to press, prints of all the titles listed were in stock ready for shipment. Normally, within two or three weeks after mailing, 50% or more of the titles will have been sold.

As to the length of 16mm. film - cartoons average about 250 feet to a reel, other non-reelers run 300 to 350 feet. Two-reelers usually contain about 650 feet and longer subjects normally average not less than 750 feet to a reel. All films at one reel length and over are supplied on two reels.

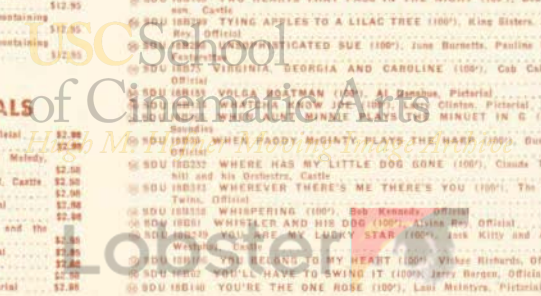

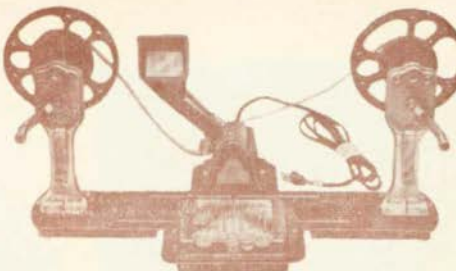

Our Guarantee

This guarantee provides that if for any reason you do not wish to retain any films or merchandise you order from Blackhawk, you may ship them back to us, transportation paid, within five days after you receive them, together with a copy of your invoice, and we'll give you full credit. Of course, returned merchandise must be in substantially the same condition when returned as when you received it. If films are returned or sent for trade-in, it will usually be ten days to two weeks before exchange merchandise or refund check will reach you.

Read This Before You Order!

Blackhawk can continually offer you these exceptional bargains only by eliminating all possibility of credit losses, and by operating our organization at the utmost efficiency. Therefore, irrespective of your credit rating, our terms are CASH WITH ORDER, or (inside continental United States) C.O.D. However, even inside continental United States a 10% deposit must accompany all C.O.D. orders of \$50.00 or more. Outside continental United States - and this includes Alaska, Canada, Hawaii, Mexico, Porto Rico and the Panama Canal Zone - we can handle orders only when remittances in full are included. In all cases, we urge you to remit by postal or express money orders, or by bank drafts. Do not send currency or coins - even by registered mail - for you do so at your own risk.

Foreign shipments - excluding Canada and Mexico - must total a minimum of \$10.00. And, all foreign orders, including Canada and Mexico, must be paid in U. S. funds unless arrangements have been made in advance for payments in the currency of the purchaser's native country. Purchasers in Iowa must pay the 2% Iowa State Retail Sales Tax except in the case of retailers who are purchasing materials for resale, in which case this fact must be clearly stated on the order.

Export shipments, other than those by parcel post or air, should be packed in wooden crates for shipment by sea. An additional charge of \$6.00, over the cost of merchandise and actual transportation, is made for each such box required, and for packing therein in waterproof paper.

Under the new postal regulations, parcels may not exceed 30 lbs. in weight nor 72 inches in length and girth combined. This means generally that all moderate to large shipments of films must be shipped to you by Railway Express, and that shipments of projectors, screens (except our folding cloth screens) and moderate to large quantities of reels and cans must go by express instead of parcel post. Whenever an item has to be shipped by express, we will send it express collect for the transportation, which you will pay on delivery.

However, on small moderate size shipments of 16mm. films, which may be sent by parcel post, if you wish to remit in full with your order, you may include the appropriate amount to cover for packing, postage and insurance, based on your address, as covered by the following three territorial groupings:

GROUP B - applies to Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Mississippi, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, Washington and Wyoming.

GROUP C - applies to Alaska, Canal Zone, Hawaii and Porto Rico, together with all other U. S. territories and possessions, Canada, Mexico, Central American and European Countries. Three 100' 16mm. prints count as one 400' 16mm. reel in figuring postage and insurance.

Each feature picture counts as eight 400' 16mm. reels in figuring postage and insurance. For empty reels, cans, cases, etc., allow 20% of purchase price for postage and insurance.

In figuring transportation charges for 8mm. films, consider two 8mm. subjects to be the equivalent of one 16mm. subject of the same length.

On many classes of films listed here, additional savings can be made by ordering six, twelve or more prints at a time. These discounts, however, apply only to quantities purchased within that class, and not to shipments of several classes of films. Discounts do not apply to any new or used films unless specifically offered in the listing.

There are no dealer discounts of any kind offered by Blackhawk - the prices quoted in this catalog, and the quantity discounts available on certain types of films, apply to all classes of purchases.
