Early Film Landmarks

AN EDISON ALBUM

(1896-1907) Silent. 11 min. at silent speed. Collection of early Edison films, including *The Kiss* (1896), *Old Maid in Drawing Room* (1900), *Street Car Chivalry* (1901), *Romance of the Rails* (1902) and *Rescued from an Eagle's Nest* (1907). \$75

MELIES TALES OF TERROR

(France, 1903-04) Silent. 11 min. at 18 f.p.s. Three George Melies subjects from his peak years, restored from Library of Congress paper prints: *The Melomaniac*, *The Monster and The Terrible Turkish Executioner*, a "grisly little farce" in which four prisoners, decapitated on camera, reconstitute themselves and take revenge upon the headsman. \$75

CINEMA MAGIC OF GEORGES MELIES

(1978, color, 28 min.) French film-maker Georges Melies was one of the film's greatest pioneers. This documentary by Patrick Montgomery traces Melies career as conjurer and film producer, director, and designer from the late 19th century through his period of world fame to old-age obscurity. The rare film excerpts are of excellent quality. The film also uses personal photographs, models, drawings and other rare evidence of Melies' versatility and imagination. The film concludes with a lengthy excerpt from a beautiful, hand-colored copy of *The Im-possible Voyage*. \$295.00

THOSE AWFUL HATS

(1909) 3 min., piano track. D.W. Griffith's shortest film is a humorous essay on the problem of women wearing large hats in movie theaters of the day! \$25.00

DEATH'S MARATHON

(1913) Silent, 16 min. at 18 f.p.s. Directed by D.W. Griffith for Biograph. Shot by Billy Bitzer. Starring Henry Walthall, Blanche Sweet, Lionel Barrymore, Walter Miller, Bobby Harron. \$85.00

FLYING HIGH

(1929) 20 min., sound. A genuine hybrid talkie short subject that began as a silent film and then switched to sound in the midst of production. The film opens with a dialog scene, then changes to title cards with musical accompaniment, then concludes as a talkie. A collegiate comedy with spectacular aerial sequences. Stars Bob Livingston, Walter Brennan and Andy Devine!!! \$135.

VOICE OF THE NIGHTINGALE

(1923) Silent, Color, 15 min. at 18 f.p.s. Beautiful Ladislav Starevitch animated puppet film. A little girl whose doll is broken captures a nightingale. The bird, desperately searching for his lost mate, leads the girl into a magical, undersized world of grasshoppers, crickets and butterflies and begs for his freedom. \$95.00

THE PLOW THAT BROKE THE PLAINS

(1936) 25 min. Pare Lorentz' famous social documentary film about the settling of the Great Plains, its subsequent misuse, and the ravages of nature to which the land finally succumbed in the thirties. The film carried the story of the "Dust Bowl" to millions, prompting action to reclaim and restore the land. \$195.00

MOODS OF THE SEA

(Produced in 1942, released in 1978) 10 min. A film by Slavko Vokapich and John Hoffman. Vokapich, considered the master of montage for his work in *Life and Death of a Hollywood Extra*, *The Good Earth*, *Mr. Smith Goes to Washington* and so many other classics, juxtaposes images of the sea with Mendelssohn's "Fingal's Cave" overture. By the power and magic of selection and arrangement, its captured visions become an eloquent, abstract drama of living thought and feeling. \$85.00
