





Blackhawk pays the postage on most items listed in this circular when remittance in full accompanies the order, but only when the shipment goes to a point served by the U. S. Postal Service. Some items, such as projectors, screens, tape recorders, projector stands, etc., because of size or weight, or both, do not qualify for shipment by parcel post. On these, you pay the transportation charges when the item is delivered to you by express or freight. In all cases, we have attempted to call to your attention these non-mailable items at the point where they are listed, but irrespective of this, we do not postpay or pay transportation charges on any single item too large or too heavy, when packed, to go by parcel post.

C. O. D. SHIPMENTS

Blackhawk will gladly make shipments of merchandise on a C.O.D. basis to any point in the United States or to U. S. territories and possessions. However, on C.O.D. shipments, the purchaser pays all transportation charges, insurance and C.O.D. fees, and money order fees, in addition to the cost of the merchandise. Because of the weight involved, we will not forward projectors on a C.O.D. basis unless a deposit of \$25.00 is enclosed to guarantee transportation charges, and then only within continental United States.

RIGHTS OF USE ON MOTION PICTURES

None of the motion picture prints offered herein, either new or used, may be used for television or theatrical purposes, as these rights are specifically reserved. All new 16mm. and 8mm. short subject prints (except our Laurel and Hardy comedies, Hymalogues and Songbooks of the Screen) may be shipped by us to any destination in the world. Certain feature picture prints, both used and new, and a few short subjects on which used prints are available, are restricted as to the territories in which they may be used.

SHIPMENTS TO CANADA AND MEXICO

Customers in Canada and Mexico should add 10% to the prices of all items which are normally postpaid in the United States for postpaid delivery to them. On non-postpaid items, Canadian and Mexican customers should inquire in advance as to transportation charges unless those charges may be collected on delivery. Remittance must be in U. S. funds. Minimum order is \$10.00.

FOREIGN SHIPMENTS (Other Than To Canada or Mexico)

On small orders that may be shipped by parcel post in a single package, customers in all foreign countries (as well as Canada and Mexico) may have postpaid delivery by adding 10% to the prices of the items making up the shipment, providing the items are within

the size and weight limits permitted for parcel post shipments to their country. Minimum order is \$10.00.

On all such foreign shipments that cannot be sent by parcel post in a single parcel, foreign customers must remit 5% in addition to the catalog prices of the merchandise to cover our cost of handling the necessary Customs Declarations, Letters of Credit, Pre-Form Invoices and Insurance on the Shipment. The customer must pay in addition (1) the cost of special packing for export shipment when material is to be prepared in waterproof paper and/or in wooden boxes to move by ship or air, (2) the actual cost of any Consular Invoices which the customer or his country may require and (3) transportation charges.

All foreign orders must be paid in U. S. funds. Individuals sending in small orders for their own personal use may prefer to remit by International Money Order or by Bank Draft payable in New York, Chicago, San Francisco or some other city in the United States.

If you make payment by letter of credit, it will be to your advantage if you will have your bank use the Davenport Bank and Trust Company, Davenport, Iowa, for actual issuance of the letter of credit. Your bank will undoubtedly prefer not to use the Davenport Bank and Trust Company as they will likely have no established contact there. It is customary for banks in foreign countries to use such large banks as The Chase National Bank of New York, the First National Bank of Chicago and other such institutions for Letter of Credit work. We will accept letters of credit from these banks but the use of them may well mean a delay in shipment to you.

The New York banks are better than a thousand miles from us here in Davenport, Iowa. The Chicago banks are some two hundred miles away. If the letter of credit extended to us is not perfectly clear, we have no alternative but to correspond with the bank and determine exactly their interpretation of the terms appearing on the Letter of Credit. This correspondence may take as long as two or three weeks.

On the other hand, if the Letter of Credit is put through the Davenport Bank and Trust Company, it will be simple for us to clear up any technical questions by telephone. The Davenport Bank and Trust Company is one of the larger banks in the United States and next to the largest bank in Iowa.

Foreign customers can secure full information as to Blackhawk Films' credit and reliability by having their banking houses check with Dun and Bradstreet in the United States, and with either Davenport Bank and Trust Company or First Trust and Savings Bank here in Davenport.
