The Verb (infinitive form)	The Meaning	An example
To act Translate:	To perform in a film, play etc.	He acted the part of a villain.
To act out Translate:	To perform the actions and say the words of a story.	They acted out the fairytale.
To act up Translate:	If a person, especially a child, acts up, they behave badly.	He always acted up when his friends were watching.
To auction Translate:	To sell goods or property to the highest bidder.	They auctioned all their art.
To clown about Translate:	To act like a clown.	He always clowned about in the class.
To entertain Translate:	To keep a group of people interested or amused.	He entertained the troops during the war.
To lose Translate:	To fail to succeed in a game, competition, etc.	He lost all his money at the casino.
To perform Translate:	To entertain people by dancing, singing, acting or playing music.:	She performed her own composition in the concert.
To play along Translate:	To do what someone asks you to do, for a limited period of time.	We played along with the idea, until we were able to run away.
To play out Translate:	To be outside playing	It was a nice day, so the kids played outside.
To play up Translate:	To behave badly be difficult.	He always played up when his friends were watching.
To sing Translate:	To make musical sounds with the voice.	She sang her heart out.
To star Translate:	To be the main person in a film, play.	She's starred in more hits than I can count.
To throw Translate:	To send something through the air with force.	She's thrown a double six!
To understudy Translate:	To learn the part of another actor in a play.	He understudied for Lawrence Olivier.
To win Translate:	To succeed in a game, competition.	They won a lot of money at the bingo.
