<b>Break away</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To escape from captivity	The horses were enclosed in a paddock but a few of them managed to <i>break away</i> .
<b>Break away from</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To leave and become independent	He <i>broke away</i> from the organisation and set up his own agency.
<b>Break down</b> <i>Translate:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To stop functioning.</li> <li>• To lose control of one's emotions.</li> <li>• To divide into small or simpler parts.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• David's car <i>broke down</i> on the way to the airport.</li> <li>• The parents <i>broke down</i> when they heard the bad news.</li> <li>• The lesson will be easier to learn if you <i>break it down</i> into small sections.</li> </ul>
<b>Break free</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To detach from a physical hold.	Eva managed to <i>break free</i> from her attacker's grasp.
<b>Break in</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To enter by force in order to steal something.	Bob saw a man outside trying to <i>break in</i> .
<b>Break into</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To enter a place by force in order to steal something.	The burglars <i>broke into</i> the house after midnight.
<b>Break in on</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To interrupt unexpectedly	An operator suddenly <i>broke in on</i> our telephone conversation.
<b>Break off</b> <i>Translate:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To stop or discontinue.</li> <li>• To stop speaking</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It was decided to <i>break off</i> diplomatic relations with that country.</li> <li>• She <i>broke off</i> in the middle of a sentence.</li> </ul>
<b>Break out</b> <i>Translate:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To start suddenly.</li> <li>• To have a skin infection</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rioting <i>broke out</i> as a result of the strike.</li> <li>• I broke out in a terrible rash after touching a plants</li> </ul>
<b>Break out of</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To escape from a place by force	Three prisoners <i>broke out of</i> jail.
<b>Break through</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To force a way through something	The car <i>broke through</i> the barrier.
<b>Break up</b> <i>Translate:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To come to an end (relationship).</li> <li>• To separate into small pieces</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After her marriage <i>broke up</i> Emma went to live in London.</li> <li>• He used a fork to <i>break up</i> the soil.</li> </ul>
<b>Break with</b> <i>Translate:</i>	To discontinue something or do something in a different way.	He <i>broke with</i> tradition and invented new methods.
