Phrasal Verb	Meaning	Example
Call after Translate:	Give a newborn baby the same name as someone else.	The baby is called after his grandfather.
Call at Translate:	Stop somewhere briefly (ship, train, etc.)	The train calls at Oxbridge and Glenville.
Call away Translate:	Ask someone to leave a place.	The doctor was called away for an emergency.
Call back Translate:	Return a phone call.	I'll call you back as soon as possible.
Call for Translate:	 Go somewhere to get someone. Demand that something be done. Be required or necessary. Be an appropriate occasion. 	 Tom said he would call for her at 8 o'clock. The authorities called for an investigation. The job calls for excellent computer skills. The good news calls for champagne!
Call in Translate:	 Make a phone call to a place. Ask someone to come and do a job. To pay a visit to someone. 	 Eva called in to say that she was ill. He called in the plumber to repair the leak. Jack called in on his parents yesterday.
Call off Translate:	Cancel	The picnic was <i>called off</i> due to the storm.
Call on Translate:	Formally request or invite	I now call on the President to address the assembly.
Call out Translate:	Shout something	He called out my name but I didn't answer.
Call round Translate:	To go to visit someone.	The nurse said she would <i>call round</i> to see my mother.
Call up Translate:	To phone someone.To summon for military service.	 Tom has a list of people to <i>call up</i> today. My grandfather was <i>called up</i> during the war.
