The Verb (infinitive form)	The Meaning	An example (Simple Past Tense)
To carpet Tranlate:	To cover a floor with a carpet.	My mother carpeted her house, but I prefer wooden floors.
To clean Tranlate:	To organise, put away things and clean.	I cleaned the house yesterday.
To decorate Tranlate:	To make a room more attractive with paint/wallpaper.	I decorated the kitchen yellow.
To furnish Tranlate:	To put furniture into a room.	I furnished the lounge with contemporary furniture.
To paint Tranlate:	To cover the surface of a wall or ceiling with paint.	I painted the ceiling white.
To paper Tranlate:	To stick wallpaper on the walls of a room.	I papered the room in my favourite colour.
To plaster Tranlate:	To cover a wall with plaster or a similar substance.	The brick walls were very damp, so we plastered them.
To rent Tranlate:	To live somewhere you do not own by paying a regular amount of money.	When I was a student I rented a small room at the University.
