<b>The Verb (infinitive form)</b>	<b>The Meaning</b>	<b>An example (Simple Past Tense)</b>
<b>To carpet</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To cover a floor with a carpet.	My mother carpeted her house, but I prefer wooden floors.
<b>To clean</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To organise, put away things and clean.	I cleaned the house yesterday.
<b>To decorate</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To make a room more attractive with paint/wallpaper.	I decorated the kitchen yellow.
<b>To furnish</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To put furniture into a room.	I furnished the lounge with contemporary furniture.
<b>To paint</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To cover the surface of a wall or ceiling with paint.	I painted the ceiling white.
<b>To paper</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To stick wallpaper on the walls of a room.	I papered the room in my favourite colour.
<b>To plaster</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To cover a wall with plaster or a similar substance.	The brick walls were very damp, so we plastered them.
<b>To rent</b> <i>Tranlate:</i>	To live somewhere you do not own by paying a regular amount of money.	When I was a student I rented a small room at the University.
