The Verb	The Meaning	An example
To bump off Translate:	To murder someone (slang).	He didn't die of natural causes, someone bumped him off.
<b>To bury</b> Translate:	To put a dead body into the ground.	We buried him in December.
To commit genocide Translate:	To murder a whole group of people, especially a whole nation.	Mr Powell concluded that that genocide had been committed in Darfur.
To commit suicide Translate:	If a person commits suicide, they kill themselves.	Ian Curtis committed suicide by hanging at the age of 23.
To cremate Translate:	To burn a body, usually as part of a funeral ceremony.	She was cremated.
To croak (it)	Impolite expression to say that someone has died.	I hear that he croaked it during the night.
To die Translate:	To stop living or existing, either suddenly or slowly.	My mother died in 2005.
To drop dead Translate:	To die suddenly and unexpectedly.	He dropped dead in the middle of a game of cards.
To drown Translate:	To die under water.	Many sailors drown.
To execute Translate:	To kill someone as a legal punishment.	He was executed for mass murder.
To give birth Translate:	When a woman or female animal gives birth, she produces a baby from her body.	She gave birth to twins. A boy and a girl.
To grow up Translate:	To gradually become an adult.	I grew up in England.
<b>To kill</b> Translate:	To cause someone or something to die.	It is estimated that smoking kills 120,000 people every year.
To live Translate:	To continue, to be alive or have life.	She lived for 100 years.
To murder Translate:	The crime of intentionally killing a person.	It is thought that Dr Harold Shipman murdered 400 people.
To pass away Translate:	A polite expression for dying.	He passed away last year.
To suffocate Translate:	To die because of a lack of oxygen.	The autopsy showed he suffocated.
