To form an affirmative phrase in the present simple we use a PRONOUN + VERB before the rest of the of the sentence. Please note that the spelling for the 3rd /third person changes and we either add: **s, es** or **ies** according to the spelling rules.

*Para forma una frase afirmativa en el presente simple utilizamos un PRONOMBRE + VERBO antes del resto de la oración. Por favor notar que la dele tracción por la tercera persona cambia and o bien añadimos: **s, es, o ies** según las reglas de ortografía.*

We form the present tense using the base form, 1st column, of the infinitive (without the TO).
 Formamos el tiempo presente utilizando la forma base, la 1^a columna, del infinitivo (sin el TO).

- As a rule, in the third person we add '**S**'.
 Como regla, en la tercera persona añadimos '**S**'.

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3. For verbs that end in **-O, -CH, -SH, -SS, -X, or -Z** we add **'ES'** in the third person.

4. For verbs that end in a **consonant + Y**, we remove the **Y** and add **'IES'**.
