Cleaning tips for your wooden floor

Wooden floors are really hot right now, but in fact they never go out of fashion and are additionally beautiful. So, how can you make your wooden floor look fantastic year after year? Here are some great tips to make your beautiful wood floor look clean and radiant.

- Avoid using harsh detergents such as "Pine Sol" or bleach on wood floors. Such detergents
 can damage your hardwood floor and make them look dull and worn. To maintain a fresh,
 deep and beautiful appearance of your floor, keep away from such detergents. Instead, look
 for detergents specially designed to clean wooden floors, or strive to use more natural
 detergents that you can do at home.
- When sweeping the floors, use a brush with soft bristles. A broom is not a good idea to use
 on this type of floor as they can eventually scratch your floors and make them look dull and
 worn. Find a rubbish with soft straws at your local shop that sells cleaning products or
 construction stores.
- If you regularly use a vacuum cleaner, make sure you use the nozzle with the soft brushes rather than the hard ones. This will let the vacuum cleaner soak up all dirt and loose objects without scratching the wood or damaging the surface of your wood floor.
- Consider using carpets in areas where there is a lot of traffic in your home. This keeps the floor under the carpet clean and also protects the floor. Vacuum frequently off the carpets to prevent dirt from getting through the tissue and repairing the floor. This is a great help in keeping your hardwood floor clean.
- When moping make sure to use only one moist mop. You do not want excess water on your
 wooden floor as it can easily destroy it. If something is spilled on the wooden floor, be sure to
 dry it immediately to prevent the floor from being destroyed!
- Wooden floors should be moped daily or every other day. This makes the floor shine and keeps it clean so it continues to be beautiful. It also removes dirt that can sink into the floor when you walk on it. By keeping the dirt at a minimal level, you can prevent this.
- If your floor is oiled, use only cleaners for oiled wood floors. Anything that is not approved for this purpose can damage the surface of the floor or even damage the floor under the surface layer.

To make sure your wooden floors are absolutely beautiful, follow the tips above. The key to making the floors always look fantastic in general is to be careful when cleaning them, and to clean them frequently. Keep sand, dirt and dust away from your floors and by placing carpets in high-traffic areas, you will be helped. High traffic areas can be doors, halls, corridors and living rooms. It's a great idea to have a rug under the dining tables to minimize scratches and damage from dropped food. By doing so, you can maintain the beauty of your hardwood floors and you will also protect them!
